'We deliver ice cream. I don't think a lot of people know that," Van Beveren said.

Max Pizza II provides this ice cream for free to high school students during their after-graduation party.

This is just one of the many

ways that the restaurant is involved with the people of New Britain.

"We try to stay really involved in the community," Van Beveren said.

Max Pizza II sells its pizzas at a discounted price for resale at local sporting events. This allows local sports teams and other organizations to raise money.

In other instances, Max Pizza II is part of the curriculum itself. Schools in the area organize field trips to see the inner workings of the restaurant. A scavenger hunt is set up for students to enhance learning opportunities and exploration, Van Beveren said.

Schools and other local businesses take advantage of the restaurant's catering services as well.


