For new businesses and old, having a healthy network of community relationships during a pandemic can help deal with ongoing challenges.

"Most chamber of commerce organizations are advocates for their business community, that's what we are here for," said Bill Moore, president of the Greater New Britain Chamber of Commerce. "But we have to adapt and have been able to adapt," he said. "Our efforts are geared towards enhancing the economic health and vitality and quality of life for the entire Greater New Britain region, trying to touch all aspects to help people grow and thrive. It's been challenging but I am hopeful that we will continue to do well."
