As an opportunity to educate and serve the community of Central Connecticut, the vein centers began providing these new vein therapy techniques in an office setting, opening its practice in New Britain in 2004, eventually expanding to Madison in 2008 and Wallingford in 2017.

Midstate Radiology Associates acquired New Britain Radiological Associates in 2017 and expanded and upgraded the vein centers suite in Wallingford in August 2020.

Every initial consultation at vein centers starts off with a medical history, a focused physical examination, a diagnostic ultrasound evaluation by a certified registered vas-
